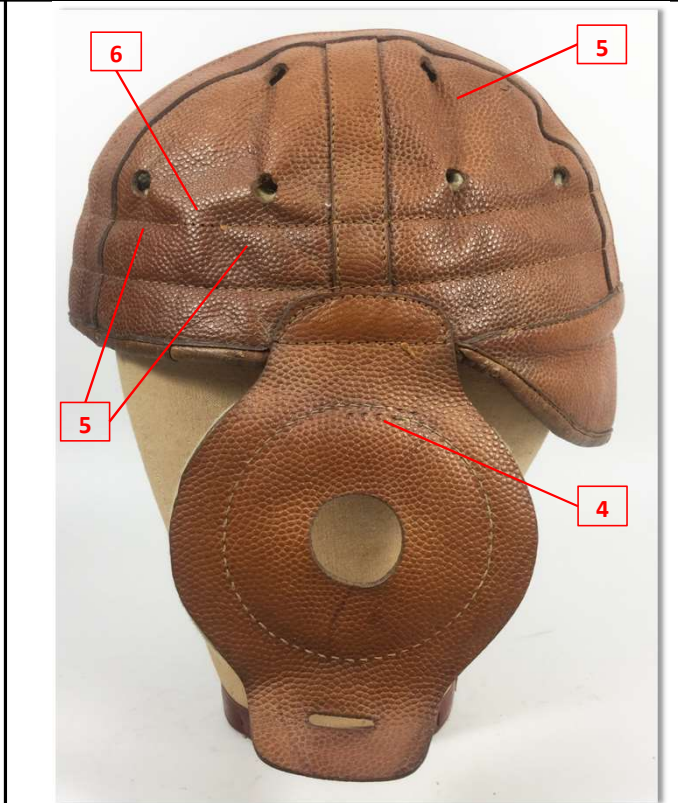

About the Raincap Head Harness

The Raincap style football helmet refers to soft leather, canvas, or moleskin helmets with rounded crowns that could be folded in half easily. Countless variations of the raincap were sold over a 25 year period from 1900 - 1925. Raincaps typically possess independent ear flaps sewn onto the body of the harness, which is padded with cotton or wool.



DUDLEY HEAD HELMETS

No. 43BX. Soft brown leather, heavily padded.....\$1.75

No. 43BBX. Soft black leather, heavily padded.....\$1.75

No. 44BX. Soft leather and well padded.....\$1.25
